John 3:31

- What position or place of recognition does John ascribe to Jesus?
- From Heaven and Above all
- What difference does that make for you and me?

John 3:32

- What are some things that Christ has seen and heard?

- “Of the Father, of his mind and will, of his purposes and promises, of his love, grace, and mercy, in the council and covenant of peace, lying in his bosom, and being privy to all his secrets. The phrases express the clear and perfect knowledge Christ has of all truths and doctrines; he having all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge in him.” GIL

John 3:32

- Why does man not accept the testimony of Christ?

- Natural beings cannot understand spiritual things unless they are drawn to Him
(1 Corinthians 2:14)

John 3:33

- What is the testimony that Christ presented?
- God is truth
- Those who believe “set their seal” or attest to the testimony that it is valid and reliable

John 3:34

- How did Christ have the Holy Spirit? Is this different than O.T. prophets, N.T. apostles, and current ministers? How does this affect you and me?
- He had the Spirit without measure; this was different from those who received a “measured” amount: i.e. certain spiritual gifts

John 3:35

- Describe the relationship that the Father has with the Son?
- He loves Him; He has given all things into His hands
- What difference does that make for you and me?

John 3:36

- What is the result of belief?
- Everlasting life

John 3:36

- What are the results of unbelief?
- No eternal life
- Experience the wrath of God
